# How to get to Derby

# By train

Derby is served by trains operated by East Midlands Railway and Cross Country.

**East Midlands Railway** operates direct trains to Derby from Sheffield, Chesterfield, Nottingham, Newark, Matlock, Crewe, Stoke on Trent, Loughborough, Leicester and London St. Pancras.

From Lincoln to Derby, change at Nottingham.

East Midlands Railway also operates a service between Liverpool and Norwich. Derby can be reached from Liverpool, Manchester and Stockport by changing at Sheffield or Chesterfield or at Crewe. From Norwich, change at Nottingham.

From Market Harborough, Kettering, Wellingborough, Bedford and Luton change at Leicester

**Cross Country** operates direct trains from Birmingham, Cheltenham, Gloucester, Worcestershire Parkway, Bristol, Cardiff, Newport, Sheffield, Leeds, York, Newcastle and Edinburgh.

Cross Country also operate a Stanstead Airport to Birmingham service, Derby can be reached from Cambridge, Ely and Peterborough by changing at Leicester.

# From the station to the cathedral (leave via the main entrance, NOT the Pride Park entrance)

**On foot** – it is about 1¼ miles.

- Cross the road outside the station, take the paved street between the Merry Widows pub and the Waterfall,
- in 110 yards turn right onto Park Street. Near the inner ring road go down the ramp, on the left, to a subway which takes you into the Derbion Centre.
- Go up the escalator, at the top go straight on past M&S to the exit on London Road, Wilko is opposite.
- Turn right, keep straight on you will pass St Peter's church, Lloyds Bank and the Market Place at which point you will see the Cathedral Tower.

**By Bus** – services Skylink Derby, (Kinchbus, usually yellow), 1 and 1A (Arriva, various shades of blue) go from stop S1 at the front of the station and all go to the Bus Station. Due to the vagaries of the one way system no outbound buses stop near the Cathedral. It is nearer to walk from the Bus Station. Use the exit on the left near bay 16 which will take you to the River Derwent. At the next bridge, cross the road and continue on the riverside path, after passing the rear of the Premier Inn you will see the Cathedral to the left.

Taxis are available from the station, the rank is to the left of the station entrance.

## By car

#### From the north

Derby is 15.5 miles from Junction 28 of the M1, then take A38 Derby.

From Manchester the A6 comes to Derby, but it is not a fast road, going cross country to the M1 might be a better prospect.

#### From the south

Derby is 10.5 miles from Junction 24 of the M1, take A50 then A6 towards Derby.

#### From the west

The A38 from Birmingham and the A52 from The Potteries meet at Markeaton Park on the western side of Derby, in both cases follow the A38 to the junction with the A6, Duffield Road, follow signs for City Centre. This will ensure you are facing the right way to access the Cathedral and its environs. It has to be said that the Derby traffic system has its idiosyncrasies.

#### From the east

The main road from the Nottingham direction is the A52, follow the signs for the City Centre, then Matlock (A6), as you leave the inner ring road you will see the Cathedral tower to your left.

Looking at Google Street view is recommended.

# **Car Parking**

**Derby Cathedral car park**. This is situated in St. Michael's Lane, about 130 yards from the Cathedral. There is a rather squat redundant church on the corner. On Saturday the car park is used by shoppers and Leisure Centre users and there is a charge –cash only.

There is generally room there but if not go to Chapel Street. Go back to the top of St. Michael's Lane, turn right, turn left at lights, turn left at the Flowerpot pub (70 yards) and the entrance to Chapel Street car park is on your right.

**Chapel Street Multi Storey car park.** This is situated on Chapel Street and is about 200 yards from the Cathedral. Cost (March 2022) is £7.20 for over 5 hours.
